premium rum category.

Tasting aims: Balance, elegance, smooth, rich with an aromatic complexity.

Points of difference: - The only XO at this retail selling price.

- The only carafe at this price.

- This rum comes out top in blind tastings (in black glasses)

against its direct competitors.

Usage: On its own or as a cocktail base.

Tasting notes: On the nose: cinnamon, cocoa, exotic fruits, dry grapes.

Complex mouth, smooth and honeyed without being sugary.



Origin: Guatemala. Alcohol: 40%.

Positioning: The best rum from Guatemala.

Tasting aims: Balance, elegance, smoothness, strength, aromatic complexity

and length.

Process: Selection of the best barrels in the cellars of Guatemala. Importation.

Blending. Final, complementary ageing in the Charente.

Points of difference: - High-end packaging.

Ageing: Initial ageing in Guatemala. Final ageing in the Charente.

Usage: On its own.

Tasting notes: Exceptional balance between a rich bouquet, a smooth taste, not

overly sweet, complex aromas and remarkable length. An exquisite

rum, especially for the connoisseurs.



Origin: Guatemala. Alcohol: 52%.

Sugar content: 10 g / liter

Positioning: The 'natural' rum from Guatemala containing the strict

minimum of additives.

Tasting aims: Fruit, intensity, strength, taste, length.

Process: •Selection of the best barrels in our cellars giving preference to:

- Fruit rather than wood:

- Natural smoothness rather than sugar;

- Moderate alcoholic strength to limit dilution.

•Blending and final ageing in our cellars in Charente.

Points of difference: - With its fruity nose and a taste close to the 'agricole' rums, Pasador 52 has a unique personality;

- A blend which privileges simplicity and strength;

- The authenticity of Guatemala at its simplest;

- Extremely elegant packaging.

**Usage: Tastings** 

Tasting notes: The nose is dominated by a range of exotic fruits (mangos, passion fruit, peaches) and by hints of baking. The taste is clear, full and lingering. The finish is very long, thanks to its power and the

persistance of the yellow fruits.
